

House Rules

We are delighted to welcome you back but in line with Government guidelines to keep you safe your experience is going to be a little different but you will still receive that warm Chequers welcome and atmosphere.

Our utmost priority is to keep you, ourselves and our team safe. Please follow social distancing and good hygiene practices at all times. If you have any concerns about the processes please let our session manager know.

- Seating is mainly outside and in the marquee with table service from our team. Sorry there's no standing at the bar or inside.
- Please ensure you follow the current Government guidance on meeting people from outside your household.
- Due to our table sizes we will only take bookings for groups of up to 6 people.
- To comply with Government guidelines we will collect the name and telephone number of the lead contact of your group. This information is to enable us to be compliant with the NHS Track & Trace systems. We can confirm that this information will only be used for this purpose and will be securely stored. The information will only be kept for 21 days.
- We've moved these tables around a lot to get some nice spaces! so please do not move your table.
- Toilets are on a 1 in 1 out basis. Please wait until it is your turn and use the hand washing facilities. Both ladies and gentlemen to use the cubicle.
- Please follow the one way system if you are asked to do so by a member of staff and observe all signs
- In the event of bad weather if you take cover you must adhere to social distancing. If this is not possible we have containers for you to take your drinks and food away with you.
- Tables currently have a 2 hour slot but if your table is not needed you are very welcome to stay.
- We want everyone to enjoy their visit to The Chequers so anyone not conforming to our guidelines will be asked to leave and not able to finish their drink or food.
- We will follow the processes recommended by the Government which many change from time to time.
